- Buildings and Grounds
 - S'ville Facility
 - Plumbing issues. Current toilets expensive to replace (over \$700 each)
 - Automatic Door needs to be replaced approx cost \$10,000
 - Both Facilities
 - All necessary and suggested steps are being undertaken to combat Covid-19 outbreak.
 - 1 positive. 4-5 exposure (all tested negative)
 - Monitoring DHEC, CDC and Dorchester County for guidance
- New Facilities
 - County has worked out a deal with the Heritage Center in concept
 - To acquire 4-5 acres from the Heritage Center site
 - Their architect and the Library Board architect will consult and determine where in parcel board will acquire prior to financial purchase
 - Select staff attended a meeting with architects where staff was surveyed on concepts and needs were discussed with Architects

 - 1 full time and 3 part time
 - St. George Facility
 - 2 full time
 - Currently have 4 open positions
 - Will have more open positions as they look to hire approximately 30 people for the expansion
 - Would hire staff for new site 60 days prior to a new site opening.
